August, A Season of Prayer

Luke 11:9-10

"So I say to you, Ask, and it will be given you; search, and you will find; knock, and the door will be opened for you. For everyone who asks receives, and knocks, the door will be opened."

I have a special request. Please pray with me this month of August, every day.

The power of prayer is a mystery to me. And yet, I witness it time and time again. John Wesley, founder of Methodism, so believed in prayer that he would begin his mornings with 2 hours of prayer. He was so dedicated to God seeking God's grace for the world!

We have a gasoline voucher outreach at FUMCOW. In this ministry, we partner with the Conoco gas station down the street, otherwise known as Chef Point. We hand a voucher for \$10 of gas to people who come to us looking for assistance. They, in turn, redeem these at Chef Point. A couple times a year, we reimburse Chef Point.



As a part of this outreach, we often offer a prayer square. Rae Bridegam, our Administrative Assistant crochets these. They have a beautiful cross in the middle of the square. Rae will ask for prayer needs as

she is preparing the voucher. We in-turn gather in a circle, hold hands and pray.

A woman recently came to FUMCOW looking for help. Rae asked for her prayer needs. This woman shared her story. She keeps her granddaughter, who by the way came to our Vacation Bible School this year. She shared how in a time of recent need, her granddaughter reminded her that Jesus said, "Ask, and it will be given." So they prayed. We heard about the miracle that happened. *And a child shall lead them!*

HERE IT IS! I am asking you to pray with me EVERYDAY in August. I really mean every day. Please pray for two things. First, pray for our heavenly Father to give the Holy Spirit to every person in our congregation. Second, pray for the financial health of FUMCOW, so that God is glorified.

Pick a calendar you look at frequently. In the month of August, put a reminder on each day. Then mark it when you have prayed. Be dedicated in this. Watauga is your church home. It is God's church, and you have chosen to make Watauga and the people of Watauga part of your faith journey and faith family. Every person at FUMCOW is depending on you. Finally, ask everyone you know at FUMCOW to pray this month along with you.

I do not know how God will use our prayers or how God will answer these prayers. I do know that God will answer. God is always faithful. God is good all the time.


